

Marché aux Puces, the famous flea market in Paris, has been operating since the Middle Ages. It now has more than 3000 open-air stalls.



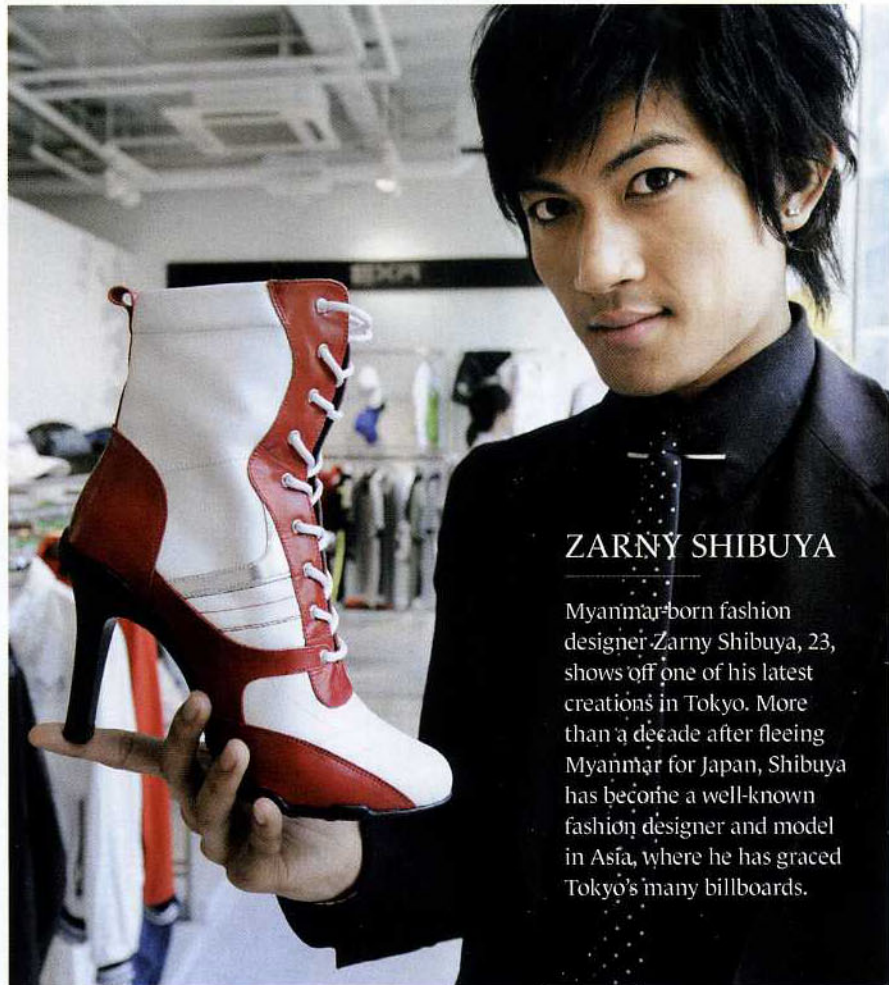
MALANDRINO
